I opened my eyes to see first the wall, white and bathed in soft white light and as I looked down there was Pastor Jeff. 2:30 in the morning standing there asking about how I was feeling! 2:30 am! We talked for a moment or two and then we prayed. He left as quietly as he arrived and the first thing I thought of was I was just visited by a guardian angel.

The church has several heating/air conditioning units providing service to the sanctuary/ancillary rooms, Johnston Hall, and the portable classrooms used by the preschool. All of these units are OLD. Now three of these big units have OUIT WORKING in the sanctuary building and are no longer repairable. REPLACEMENT is necessary.

With several bids, the trustees have a contract to start with replacement of 1 unit on the sanctuary building for \$18,000. This large expense is not in the budget so an account has been set up to collect funds for HVAC replacements. As a result, we are asking each and every congregant to reflect in their hearts and contribute any additional they can. (Please reference "for HVAC" on your contribution.) We will also be having fundraising events (the first one is the BBQ on July 10th) to raise the needed funds.

Certified Lay Minister in Waiting - Frank Remkiewicz

Frank Remkiewicz was introduced to the Oakdale Congregation last October having completed the Certified Lay Servant course of study to begin his ministry here. His goal was to become a Certified Lay Minister. Having completed all the course work, he submitted a Covenant to the Executive Board for review and approval. The Executive Board approved the covenant, along with Pastor Jeff, to continue service to the community as a Trained Lay Minister. (The only difference between a Trained Lay Minister and a Certified Lay Minister is being appointed to a specific Congregation.)

Frank's intent is to become appointed to Oakdale Community United Methodist Church as a Certified Lay Minister. Oakdale is his home and where he believes he can use God-given gifts to the maximum. In his heart and soul, Frank felt called by God to this parish to serve as a servant in the role of Lay Minister.

Pastor Jeff is now expanding Frank's role as a Trained Lay Minister recognizing in the next year he will be Certified by the Superintendent and the District Committee of Ministry. His role as a Lay Minister is defined in the Methodist Book of Discipline.

Pastor Jeff has sought and been granted permission for Frank to serve as if he was already certified while he traverses the Certification process. As you will read in another part of this newsletter, Frank is now positioned to be "on call" Mondays so that Pastor Jeff can take a day off to "re-energize his batteries".

As time passes Frank will be taking on more additional duties as a servant of God to provide wanted and needed ministries.
