

Part 1 - What Is Grace?

Ever stop and wonder about grace? I do not know about you but I don't. I pretty much take grace for granted. Surely a gift from God, but like so many gifts they become just another part of my day. I know I have it, I know God gave it to me, I know I can use it, so what else is there to know? Well, I am not sure, that is why I decided to write a column on it. We can learn together. My primary source is <u>The Book of Discipline United Methodist Church, 2016 For United Methodists</u>, This book is the rock of our Methodism.

"¶ 101. The General Book of Discipline reflects our Wesleyan way of serving Christ through doctrine and disciplined Christian life." (Part II. General Book of Discipline). It is what I would refer to as a "heavy or thick" read. What I mean by that is that almost every line has information that should be contemplated and digested to its fullest. The concept of grace is one such read.

"Grace pervades our understanding of Christian faith and life. By grace we mean the undeserved, unmerited, and loving action of God in human existence through the ever-present Holy Spirit." (*Book of Discipline*). In the Book of Discipline it is referred to as one several distinct emphasis of John Wesley.

Undeserved: we, as a people do not deserve nor does God somehow owe us this gift. Unmerited: we did not and in fact cannot earn this gift. And it is only because God loves us so much does God give us the gift of grace through the Holy Spirit. And here is an important idea to me. God wants us to have this gift of grace. God wants us to be in a loving relationship, a blessed union. Furthermore, God wants us to want to be in this relationship.

The catch is, and there always seems to be a catch, we are flawed human beings. Our continuing propensity to sin throws up a "wall" between us and God. But even now, God gives us another gift, that of His son, Jesus Christ. And in some old archaic language, "He is the propitation for our sins." In our modern language, "Jesus is the atonement for our sins."

And so, as a matter of fact, in order to restore God's image in our lives we accept divine grace to renew our fallen nature.

There are three types of grace that God has gifted us. They are prevenient grace, justifying grace, and sanctifying grace. In the months ahead, we will work to better understand all of these types of grace. We will find out what John Wesley had in mind and what it means to us today. In next month's newsletter, we take on a better understanding of prevenient grace.
